

## Individual interview

### 1. Objectives of the interview

For each student, the objective of the interview is to evaluate:

- his/her motivation to enter the *CentraleSupélec - McGill Bachelor of Global Engineering*;
- their career goals (their motivation to become an engineer);
- their knowledge of the program's operation;
- their interest in international studies.

### 2. General evaluation criteria

- Work and commitment to the engineering orientation
- Interest in science and technology
- Demonstrated or shown interest in innovation, response to issues related to SD (energy, transportation, technological developments to be rethought, etc.) and associated economic and societal issues
- Understanding of the role of the engineer in society
- Quick-wittedness
- Uniqueness
- Authenticity
- Coherence of the application process

### 3. Conduct of the interview (1 hour) by videoconference

During the first half hour, the candidate is given a short text to read.

During the second half-hour, the candidate answers questions from a CentraleSupélec-McGill jury on his/her motivation to join the program and on the text provided at the beginning of the interview.
